THE JOB

This is a great opportunity for the right candidate to work on enterprise web solution projects as part of the central IT Team serving the County of Santa Barbara. This position reports to the Assistant Director and will oversee a team of other web support technicians. The Web Services Team supports webmasters, application developers and other information technology professionals who are located in 20 different departments throughout Santa Barbara County. The successful candidate will be assigned as a Web Services Supervisor – (Office Automation Specialist II) and oversee and lead a team of four other Web Services Specialists.

As the Supervisor of the Web Services Team your responsibilities include the provision of reliable, responsive, secure, feature rich web services. Some supporting systems under this umbrella include:
